<p>Violation #10. Handwashing sinks, accessible & supplies Observed missing trash can at handwashing sink in bathroom. Provide trash can. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5)(d). Handwashing sinks are properly equipped with hand soap, individual disposable towels or hand drying device, and signage; and conveniently located.</p>
<p>Violation #22. Cold holding temperatures Observed mixed salad containers stored on counter in cold line, not properly cold held. Tested temperatures at 49F. Remove and store mixed salads on cold surface or submerge in ice. PIC removed and stored on bed of ice. COS. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). PHF/TCS foods, which are held cold, and not subject to an approved HACCP plan, must be maintained at 41°F.</p>
<p>Violation #47. Food & non-food contact surfaces Observed 2 door refrigerator gasket in disrepair. Replace gasket. Work order #448475 CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Equipment and utensils must be properly designed, constructed, and in good repair.</p>
<p>Violation #48. Ware washing: installed, maintained, & used; test strips Observed hot water temperature 105F at 3 compartment sink. Hot water should be 110F at 3 compartment sink. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Warewashing facilities must be approved, available, maintained, effective, and used for cleaning and sanitizing food-contact surfaces and equipment. Test strips are available and used to verify the solution is at a concentration necessary to achieve sanitization.</p>
<p>Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, & clean Observed stained and peeling paint on walls in dry storage and mop sink room. Repair and repaint affected surfaces. Repeated violation 9/16/2024 CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.</p>
